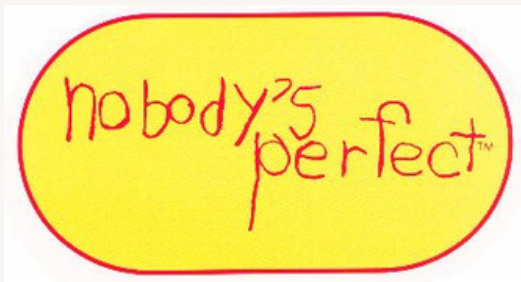


NPP CHATS 2023 VIRTUAL

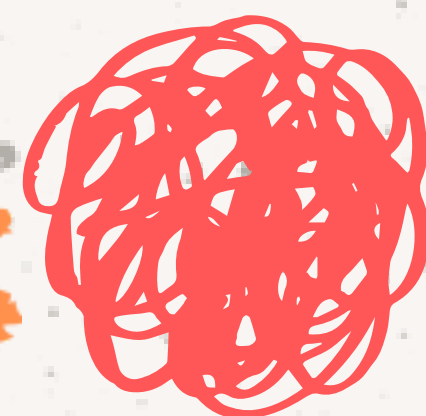
Mosaic Necomer Family Resource Network
